West Edmonton Mall Safety and Security agents work in a fast paced, multi-faceted team dynamic.

AGENTS MUST have the ability to interact effectively with all facets of society involved in all kinds of situationsand they must be able to do so in a professional manner.

AGENTS MUST have the ability to investigate a myriad of situations and problem solve to prevent future incidents from occurring.

AGENTS ARE expected to write comprehensive reports that accurately reflect the findings in their investigations. Those investigative reports are presented to the courts to secure convictions against those charged with an offense and to officials to defend liability.
